

MODULE 2: THE KEY TO REVELATION

1. LEARNING OBJECTIVES – what you will learn from the module

'The key to Revelation' unlocks the book of Revelation given to the Apostle John on Patmos – Jesus' second great end-time prophecy. We use 5 'laws' that explain the relationship and arrangement of the events signalled by seals, trumpets and bowls described in the prophecy. Once established, we may then understand its message, consider its relationship with the events of the Spine, so building a robust scriptural 'big picture' of end time prophecy.

Try to ignore the chapter and verse breaks.</p> <p><i>'Study to show yourself approved unto God, a workman who need not be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth' 2Tim 2.15</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • who gave this prophecy ? to whom was it addressed? • are there any similarities with the Spine? if so, what are they ? • why would God reveal these things to us ?
